Sunday, July 15, noon to 8 pm featuring headliners  
Work o' the Weavers, Christine Lavin and Tom Chapin**

The second concert of the New GAC POPS series will be an all-day folk concert running from noon to 8 pm on Sunday, July 15, at the upper soccer field behind the Greenwich Town Hall. The program will be curated and hosted by radio personality Bob Sherman, whose long-running folk program "Woody's Children" (familiar to many for its years on WOXR) is now heard on Sundays at 4 pm on Fordham University's WFUV (90.7 FM).

The program headlines folk stars Work o' the Weavers (who reach back to the spirit of the original Weavers of the 50's and 60's), Christine Lavin, and Tom Chapin, along with soloists James Durst and Michael Mark, and the folk and bluegrass group, Basket Landing. The program closes with a Grand Finale Hootenanny including all performers, starting at 6:30 pm.

The Greenwich Dept. of Parks & Recreation will partner with the Arts Council in presenting the folk concert on July 15. The rain location for the wall-to wall folk festival will be the Greenwich Teen Center on Arch Street.
