GAC call to Volunteers for Shakespeare on the Sound

"Friends, Romans, and countrymen....or should we say "Friends, neighbors, and Fairfield County residents, " remarks GAC Volunteer Manager Cecilia Fernandez, as the Greenwich Arts Council prepares to partner again this summer with Shakespeare on the Sound in their upcoming outdoor production of *Julius Caesar*.

Julius Caesar marks the second Greenwich season for this Rowayton-based professional theatre troupe who will bring this classic and bloody tale of political intrigue to Roger Sherman Baldwin Park for free public performances July 4 through July 13 (no performances on Mondays).
